THE NEW HAMPSHIRE MAPLE EXPERIENCE

The Rocks Estate offers a year-round maple education experience. Participants will enjoy an interactive virtual tour of the actual sap boiling process in the new sugarhouse and maple museum. Learn how this sweetest of treats was made from the times of Native Americans to present day.

This program is held in one of the original turn-of-the-century buildings on the property. Formerly the sawmill/pigpen for the farm, this building was recently remodeled to house the New Hampshire Maple Experience. The Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests, which owns the Rocks, worked in collaboration with the New Hampshire Maple Producers Association to create this unique educational experience.

Also featured will be a rotating display of maple producing artifacts, from wooden buckets and spouts, to maple sugar molds and evaporators.

This tour also features a unique photo opportunity when participants pass from one section of this historic building to the second. Framed within this section are the mountains of the Presidential Range.

Warm syrup with sour pickles, to cut the sweetness, is just one of the highlights participants will enjoy during the tour. Participants receive a Rocks maple DVD to take home. Our maple syrup and products are available in the gift shop to purchase and take home with you.
